AUDITION INFORMATION

- 1. Students must complete the application form to attend the live audition.
- 2. Students will attend a live audition outside school hours at the Large Auditorium, Secondary Campus (RSC) between 7:30am 8:30am on Monday 11 (Years 4 to 7) and Monday 18 (Years 8 to 12) November, 2024.
- 3. Selected students may be required to attend a call-back audition during school hours at the Large Auditorium, Secondary Campus (RSC). Call-back date/time TBC.
- 4. Students will be informed of their audition day/time via email.
- 5. Students will be informed of their audition result from Monday 25 November via email.
- 6. If successful, the ensembles rehearse weekly on Monday, Tuesday or Friday between 7:30am 8:30am in the Large Auditorium, Secondary Campus (RSC), during school term, and will commence in February 2025. Ensemble rehearsal days will be determined once teacher timetables for 2025 are confirmed.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Current RACE students are all required to audition unless, based on level of achievement post Showcase, teacher has granted automatic eligibility to RACE class 2025. Please check with your teachers.

Students are required to wear comfortable, fitted clothing and to bring sufficient amounts of water.

The audition process will be conducted by RACE Dance Teachers and the HOD of Performing Arts Mr. Robert Crookes. A 2025 dance tutor may be invited to attend and participate to assist the audition process.

The audition will involve teacher led technique/skills exercises and choreographic sequences. The styles covered may include Ballet, Contemporary and Jazz dance. The criteria which the audition team are looking for includes the student's demonstration of:

- Technical skills (e.g. alignment, control, coordination, turns, balances, falls, jumps, etc.)
- Expressive Skills (e.g. musicality, focus, quality of line, use of dynamics, etc.)

Intermediate and Senior RACE Dance ensembles are streamlined on technical and expressive ability of individual students, as well as best fit for a balanced dance troupe.
