Elective Subject Charges

Some of the subject choices made by students have a charge associated with them. These charges cover the cost of basic ingredients or materials that are part of, or used to produce goods that are subsequently taken home as a finished product, ie Hospitality, Home Economics, Manual Arts subjects and Artwork. Other subjects such as Health and Physical Education, Outdoor Recreation and Certificate II in Outdoor Education will have ongoing costs associated with them to cover costs of camps, buses, hire of equipment and special presentations.

Relevant Elective Subject Charges will be invoiced to parents early in Term 1 once students have settled into subjects and classes. Additional excursion and sport costs will be advised as they occur.
